Country Club
Route 95 North: Take exit 3 (123 Attleboro). After exit there is a Shell station immediately on your left. Take a left at the Shell station (this is Lathrop Road). Follow for 1.5 miles until you come to Berwick Road on your right. Take a right on Berwick and follow .5 miles. On the right is the entrance to Highland Country Club.

Route 95 South: Take Exit 3A (123 Attleboro). Go under 95 to Shell station immediately on your left. Take a left at the Shell station (this is Lathrop Road). Follow for 1.5 miles until you come to Berwick Road on your right. Take a right on Berwick and follow .5 miles. On the right is the entrance to Highland Country Club
